Overview

Albania has reached a remarkable milestone by generating 100% of its electricity from low-carbon sources, establishing itself as a leader in clean energy production. The plan sets specific targets to be achieved by 2030 such as achieving a 59. It also sets a goal to establish 200–300 electric car charging towers. Renewable energy in Albania includes biomass, geothermal, hydropower, solar, and wind energy. The climate in Albania is Mediterranean, so it possesses considerable. Hydropower is the second largest contributor to Albania's primary energy supply, after fossil fuels, and accounts for almost entirely the country's electricity generation. While hydropower seems to have been the “forgotten giant of clean electricity” as pointed out by IEA in its Hydropower Special. It is the overarching goal of the EUKI to foster climate cooperation within the European Union (EU) in order to mitigate greenhouse gas emissions.
