Angola's solar energy program has reached a milestone with the completion of seven photovoltaic plants that collectively underscore the country's pivot toward renewable power and away from diesel-based generation. Officials marked the achievement in early September with the inauguration of the. Angola has set a target of 60% access to electricity by 2025 under the strategic plan 'Visao 2025,' of which solar is poised to play a central role.
