Serbia combines modest domestic incentives for electric vehicle (EV) uptake with active efforts to integrate into EU EV supply chains through memoranda and trade agreements; its policies are a mix of short-term purchase subsidies and longer-term strategic partnerships rather than a fully developed. The Regulation on the conditions and procedures for implementing subsidized purchases of new electric vehicles, adopted by the Ministry of Environmental Protection, was approved at today's session of the Government of the Republic of Serbia.
