

Is it good to install photovoltaic panels on the roof for thermal insulation



Overview

To help accelerate that shift, the revised Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD) states that rooftop solar panels must be installed on all new buildings, public buildings and existing non-residential buildings which undergo a major renovation, all according to the time schedule shown. Rooftop solar panels, also known as photovoltaic (PV) panels, are being installed at record pace across the EU — and will soon be mandatory. That's good news but also raises serious fire safety concerns. According to the International Energy Association (IEA), PV solar generation increased by a record 22% in 2021 and “is becoming.
